- 1 Date or month of Shearing must be stated on Entry Form and also whether machine or hand shorn.
- 2 When a sheep is not bred by the Exhibitor, the breeder's name must be given.
- 3 No sheep may be entered in more than one class, except as provided for.
- 4 The Commercial classes is deemed to be for Exhibits which were bred for commercial purposes and not for the breeding of Rams which are intended to be sold.
- 5 **No Exhibits in the unhoued sections are to have had any artificial treatment such as shedding, oiling or clipping.**
- 6 The Judge and Chief Steward will have the right to disqualify any sheep deemed not to be within these rules. **This rule will be strictly enforced.**
- 7 A sheep showing an uneven number of teeth is eligible to compete in the higher classes - instead of being disqualified.
- 8 In the event of two or more Exhibitors securing the same number of points for Special Prizes, such Exhibitors may mutually agree to purchase the other's claim to same for half cost of such trophy, but the name of both Exhibitors must be attached to same. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st: 3 points, 2nd: 2 points, Champion: 1 point
- 9 **A completed "National Sheep Health Statement (Version 2 - August 2011)" form must accompany all entries - (See enclosed form)**
- 10 All entries to come from the OJD protected zone or have MN status.

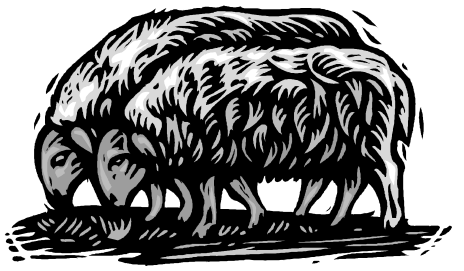

Conditions of Entry:

- 1 All Sheep in this section to be penned by 8am Saturday and shall not be removed before 4pm.
- 2 Ages of Sheep shall be determined by teeth and not by age.
- 3 All Sheep to be bona-fide property of the Exhibitor.
- 4 Shorn sheep to carry not more than 4cm wool.
- 5 In each class requiring a 'Pair of 2' the entries are to have similar characteristics. These animals can be taken from other classes or brought in as extra entries.
- 6 All Sheep in this Section must be registered in accordance with rules of the appropriate breed association. All Sheep under 18 months must be bred by the Exhibitor.
- 7 Pens are sufficient for two Sheep.
- 8 All entries must be from accredited Brucellosis free flocks. Accreditation certificate must be produced on request.
- 9 All Exhibitors to sign the Indemnity and Waiver form.
- 10 **A completed "National Sheep Health Statement (Version 2 - August 2011)" form must accompany all Entries - (See enclosed form).**
- 11 **All entries to be NLIS tagged.**
- 12 **Sheep with MN status will be yarded separately.**
